

INFORMATION ON REGULATIONS OF PACKAGES AND PACKAGING WASTE (94/62/EC) FOR PRODUCT PACKAGING

Directive 94/62/EC of December 1994 is concerned with minimization of the creation of packaging waste material and promotes energy recovery, re-use and recycling of packaging. The Packaging Directive covers all packaging placed on the market within the EU, and all packaging waste whether disposed of at industrial sites, commercial sites or private homes.

Please declare, that when leaving your factory, all you qualities meets the requirements of the EC Commission Directive, relating to Packages and Packaging waist - 94/62/EC published in the „Journal of the European Communities of 20. December 1994 (and last Amendments 2013/2 EG from 07.02.2013), in France: Law 2007-1467 from 29.10.2007.

It includes declaration concerning presence of heavy metals (CR 13695-1) or toxic/hazardous materials (CR 13695-2) and meeting the requirements of art. 11/3:

1. The sum of concentration's levels of lead, cadmium, mercury and chrome VI doesn't reach the 100ppm (CR 13695-1). If present - declare concentration.

2. Packaging does not present toxic or hazardous chemical substances or materials (CR 13695-2).

3. EN 13428 Packaging - Requirements specific to manufacturing and composition - Prevention by source reduction

4. Concerning the requirements of 94/62/EC please also confirm one of these statements:

1. Packaging can be recycled concerning EN 13430;
2. Packaging can be energetically treated concerning EN 13431;
3. Packaging can be recovered through composting and bio gradation concerning EN 13432;
4. Packaging can be re-used EN 13429.

These confirmations also means, that your responsibilities respectively your packaging meets the requirements of the EN 13427.
