&

1. IFFR Pro/International Film Festival Rotterdam, based on (3012 EJ) Kruiskadehof 36 B, Rotterdam, KvK 006809911, legally represented by Vanja Kaludjercic.

ROTTERDAM LAB

- The Partner will nominate and support one (1) emerging producer (hereinafter: the Participant), to participate in the edition of Rotterdam Lab 2025 (February 1-5).
- The Partner shall provide the name and contact of the Participant no later than Friday, November 15th, 2024.
- Each participant will receive a CineMart Badge and 5 nights of accommodation in one of the festival hotels.
- Participants will be mentioned (online) in a number of IFFR Pro publications and the Rotterdam Lab Reader.

OTHER

- 1 CineMart Badge for a representative of Lithuanian Film Centre
- 1 hotel room (single use) for 3 nights of accommodation in one of the festival hotels.

Duration of the agreement

The partnership between the Partner and IFFR will begin on the date this agreement is signed by both parties and will come to an end on 10 February 2025.

Termination/Code of Conduct

If the Partner or any third party hired by the Partner, acts in violation of the Code of Conduct as published on iffr.com, or otherwise compromises or damages the reputation of IFFR, IFFR might terminate the Contract.

Dispute Resolution and governing law

IFFR and the Partner agree that in the event a dispute arises with respect to any provision of this Partnership Agreement, they will in good faith try to resolve their differences. In the event that they are unsuccessful, they agree to seek to settle any dispute by mediation in the Netherlands.

Conditions

If as a result of or in connection with a force majeure event, IFFR cancels, postpones, relocates or modifies the event, IFFR is obliged to take all reasonable steps to mitigate the circumstance and resume performance of the contract immediately upon its cessation.

The other party shall be promptly notified in writing of the circumstance of force majeure and the duration of the expected delays. If the interruption is expected to last more than one month, both parties shall be entitled to terminate the contract without delay.

This Partnership Agreement is governed by the laws of the Netherlands.
