

ONE-TIME INTELLECTUAL SERVICES AGREEMENT No. VPS-2025/ 18
April 23, 2025, Vilnius

The Vilnius Gaon Museum of Jewish History, (hereinafter referred to as the Museum), represented by the Director PhD Simonas Strelcovas, acting in accordance with the regulations of the Museum, and [REDACTED] (hereinafter referred to as the Performer), jointly referred to as the Parties, have entered into the following one-time intellectual services agreement (hereinafter referred to as the Agreement):

I. SUBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT

1. By this agreement, the Performer undertakes to properly prepare, to coordinate the program, to rehearse and perform the violin part (hereinafter referred to as the Services) during the Concert „A Violin in History“ which is organized by the Museum (hereinafter referred to as Concert). The Concert is scheduled to take place at the Hall of composer Anatolijus Šenderovas located in Samuel Bak Museum, Naugarduko str. 10, Vilnius on May 22, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. The Performer grants the Museum the intellectual property right to publicly publish the recording of the Concert or its fragments on the Internet, as well as to use the audio or video recordings of the Concert or its fragments indefinitely and in an unspecified territory for other non-commercial, educational purposes of the Museum (organizing exhibitions, expositions, events, education, excursions, etc.). The Performer also grants the right to the Museum to use Performer's photography for the purposes of publicizing / promoting the Concert.

II. PERFORMER'S OBLIGATIONS

1. The Performer undertakes to prepare for the provision of the Services (to properly prepare, to coordinate the program, to rehearse) by May 22, 2025 at 6:00 p.m.
2. The Performer must ensure that the rights and legitimate interests of authors and other persons are not violated during the Concert;
3. The Performer must submit a signed acceptance-transfer act of the services provided no later than 5 days after the provision of the Services.

III. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE MUSEUM

1. Upon acceptance of the Services, sign the acceptance-transfer act.
2. When using the Concert and its audio or video recordings, ensure the Author's and Performer's non-pecuniary copyrights.
3. Pay the Performer for the Services, after deducting the personal income tax paid by the Museum for the Performer from the amount of the Agreement specified below, within 30 (thirty) calendar days from the date of signing the acceptance-transfer act of the work by transferring funds to the Performer's account specified in the agreement details. The amount of the Agreement together with the personal income tax declared and paid by the Museum for the Performer constitutes 30 percent of the museum's income from ticket sales.
4. No later than 30 (thirty) calendar days from the date of signing the Service Transfer-Acceptance Act, declare and pay the Authors' personal income tax from the amount specified in Section III, Clause 3 of the Agreement, which amounts to 15 (fifteen) percent of The amount of the Agreement.

IV. TERM AND TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

1. The Agreement shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall be valid until the fulfillment of the contractual obligations of both Parties.

V. OTHER TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT

1. The Agreement shall be concluded in English language in two original copies, one for each party. The Agreement may also be concluded by signing it with electronic signatures of authorized representatives of both parties or by exchanging scanned copies of the signed Agreement between the Parties.
2. Amendments and supplements to the Agreement shall be formalized by a written agreement of the parties, which shall be an integral part of this Agreement.
3. Rights, obligations and responsibilities not provided for in this Agreement shall be established by the Civil Code of the Republic of Lithuania and the Law of the Republic of Lithuania on Copyright and Related Rights.
4. Any disputes between the parties related to the contract will be resolved through negotiations, and if the parties fail to reach an agreement through negotiations, the disputes between the parties will be resolved in the competent court of the Republic of Lithuania according to the address of the Museum's headquarters.
