



COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

New Nordic Films – Baltic Focus 2025

This Agreement is made on **17 March 2025**, by and between:

The Norwegian International Film Festival – Organizer of **New Nordic Films**
(hereinafter referred to as "NNF"),

and

Estonian Film Institute

National Film Centre of Latvia

Lithuanian Film Centre

(Hereinafter collectively referred to as the "**Partners**")

1. Purpose

This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions under which the Partners will collaborate with NNF in organizing the **Baltic Focus** within the framework of the **Nordic Co-Production Market (NCPM)**, held from **19 to 22 August 2025** in Haugesund, Norway.

2. Scope of Baltic Focus

The Baltic Focus will include:

- **2 film projects** from **Estonia**, presented at the NCPM
 - **2 film projects** from **Latvia**, presented at the NCPM
 - **2 film projects** from **Lithuania**, presented at the NCPM
 - A **panel or case study** titled "*How to Co-Produce with the Baltics*"
 - A **Baltic Reception** for Accredited Industry Delegates
 - (*Optional*) Screenings of selected Baltic films in the official festival program

3. Responsibilities of New Nordic Films (NNF)

NNF will provide the following for each selected project:

- **Accommodation (3 nights)** for one director and one producer pr. project at the official festival hotel.
 - **Travel expenses** are covered from the capital city of each Baltic country to Haugesund.
 - **Invitations and accreditation**, including meals, for at least **one industry delegate** from each Baltic country.

4. Visibility and Promotion

The Baltic Focus will receive the following visibility:

- A display of **each Partner's logo** in connection with the Baltic Focus
 - A **dedicated page** in the official NNF catalog, and description of all the selected projects
 - Highlighted in all **information material, website, newsletters, and social media platforms** from New Nordic Films

5. Cost and Payment

- The **total participation fee** per country is **€6000**
 - Should the Partners choose to cover the travel expenses for their participants independently, the fee will be reduced to **€4800**.

6. Project Selection Criteria

All submitted projects must meet the following criteria:

- Full-length **cinema feature film**, suitable for **international co-production**
 - **Moderate production budget**
 - **Parts of the budget** already secured
 - **Completed screenplay** in English (preferably)
 - The production company should have completed **at least one international co-production** (preferably)

7. General Terms

- This Agreement is valid from the date of signature until the conclusion of the NCPM 2025 and all associated deliverables.
 - Modifications to this Agreement must be made in writing and agreed upon by all Parties.
 - Any disputes arising under this Agreement will be governed by Norwegian law.
